## "CRUCIAL THERAPEUTIC CONVERSATION: The Kind of Interaction That Enlivens and Heals"

We all know the exceptional experience of a dialogue that takes off on wings of curiosity, creativity and engagement. It feels like we are not "holding such a conversation" but that *it* is *holding us*. We are surprised, not only by what the *other* has to say but by what *is coming from us!* It is both thoughtful and spontaneous. It has a life of its own and that life comes through us with its own momentum. Each expression builds on the previous one and leads to the next. It doesn't follow the usual logical rout, but its unpredictable twists and turns are leading us somewhere. It is being guided by some implicit directionality that we can only see in hindsight.

Psychotherapy at its most powerful is such a conversation.

The processes of <u>finding an alive connection to ourselves</u> - what we are just then experiencing - and <u>finding an alive connection to the other</u> are one dynamic interaction.

In this workshop we will look at the elements of genuine conversation and of focusing, and we will experiment with finding our way into such a dialogue.
